Our program has two schedules, a summer and a winter. Summer schedule begins when the children finish the school year and continues until they return to school in the fall. The winter program begins in the fall when school resumes and continues until school is out in the spring.

Our program is not here just to teach students about horses, we are here to make a positive difference in lives. Our motto is “Learning life’s lessons through horses”. Our horses and instructors help teach students to confident, independent, and unique individuals and to walk away with a feeling of accomplishment and satisfaction. We teach any level anytime!! Summer Schedule

Lessons:

- Time: Monday – Thursday 5:00 pm
- Their time includes grooming, tacking up, riding, and other horse care essentials
- Age: 4 years and up, any riding level
- Cost: \$35 per lesson (tuition paid by month)

Camps:

- Time: Monday – Friday 8:00 am – 2:00 pm
- Activities include riding instruction on our seasoned school horses, learning important facts about horse care, swimming, games, and opportunities to make new friends who share your same horsey interests!
- Age: 5 years and up, any riding level
- Orientation lesson required for riders not currently riding at Silver Lining Farm. This is a 1 hour lesson and the cost is \$35.
- Cost: \$385.00 per week

Winter Schedule

Lessons:

- Time: Monday – Thursday 3:30 pm, Saturday 9:00 am, 10:00 am, 11:00 am
- Their time includes grooming, tacking up, riding, and other horse care essentials
- Age: 4 years and up, any riding level
- Cost: \$35 per lesson (tuition paid by month)

Day Camps:

- Time: Most holidays when the children are out of school 9:00 am – 1:00 pm
- Activities include riding instruction on our seasoned school horses, learning important facts about horse care, swimming, games, and opportunities to make new friends who share your same horsey interests!
- Age: 5 years and up, any riding level
- Cost: \$85 per day

Payment and scheduling for our programs are as follows:

Lessons: We offer one orientation lesson at the rate of \$35. If the student would like to enroll in our program, we pick one day that the student will take their lesson each week. Payments for lessons are due on the 1st day of each month for the whole month. After the 5th, a late fee of \$25 will apply. If the student must miss a lesson, proper cancellation according to SLF rules entitles the student to make that lesson up another day as long as it is within 30 days. A yearly registration fee of \$30 is required upon enrollment in the program.

Summer camps: A \$100 deposit is required to hold your spot for the week of camp. The remaining balance must be paid on the first day of camp. Proper cancellation will allow the student to make up the missed day on another day of camp.

Day Camps: Our day camps are pay as you go; please call in advance to see if we are offering a camp for that day. If we are, we will reserve your spot for the day. Payment is required on the day of the camp.
